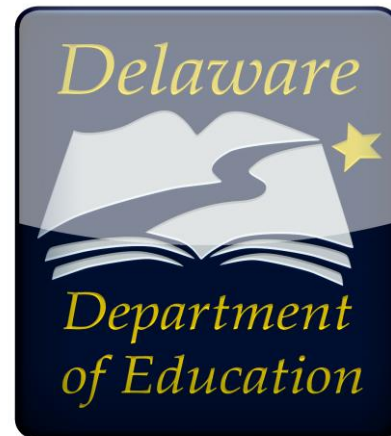

# Ignite cont.

- Delaware was ranked 28 out of 51 (50 states + the District of Columbia) on final 2013 teen births rates among females aged 15-19
- Delaware was ranked 9 out of 51 in pregnancies to females aged 15-19 in 2010



# Ignite cont.

- Delaware ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in the United States for reported cases of chlamydia among young people ages 15–19
- In 2013, the rate of AIDS diagnoses among adolescents ages 13–19 in Delaware was 3 per 100,000, compared to the national rate of 1.6 per 100,000

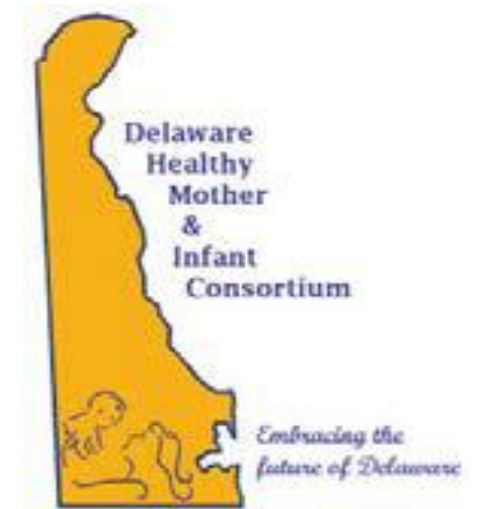
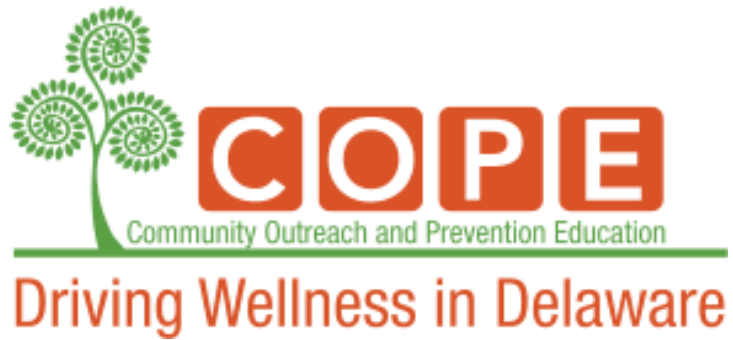
